COVID-19 vaccine survey online till January 15

BILLINGS, MT – There’s still time to register your opinions on COVID-19 vaccination in a survey conducted by RiverStone Health, Yellowstone County’s public health agency.

Nearly 3,000 people have already completed the brief, online survey of community readiness for these vaccines. We hope even more Yellowstone County residents will answer the survey to help RiverStone Health plan the distribution of the COVID-19 vaccines. Vaccines are now available in limited quantities local for health workers, senior living center residents and first responders. The supply is expected to increase, gradually making safe, effective vaccinations available to more Yellowstone County residents in the first months of 2021.

RiverStone Health is conducting an online survey to help us measure community interest in vaccination. We want to be sure to address community questions and concerns about COVID-19 and the vaccine to prevent that disease.

Answers to the survey will be anonymous, unless individuals completing the survey choose to identify themselves. All survey results will be reported as totals that don’t identify individuals.
